### The Night Before:

Make sure to get a good night's sleep. Be encouraging - "Tests are hard, you got this!" Plan for the morning.

#### Day of the Test:

Get up early to avoid rushing. Eat a good / healthy breakfast. Dress comfortably.

Be on time.

Be positive, supportive, and feeling confident:

- "You'll do a great job!"
- "Believe in yourself!"
- "I love you!"

#### **After Each Test Day:**

Talk about his/her feelings about the test.
Talk about what was easy and what was hard.
Let them know how proud you are of them.

#### When You Receive Test Results:

Sit down and review the results.

Talk about successes and challenges.

Make a plan for the following school year.
