Curriculum Corner

During the 2025 legislative session, the Texas Legislature enacted Senate Bill 12, which significantly expands parental rights in public education by increasing transparency, notification, and consent requirements around curriculum, student services, and instruction. Under SB 12, school systems must provide parents access to course syllabi or instructional plans before each semester. In compliance with this law, syllabi have been distributed to parents, and additional copies are available upon request by contacting the classroom teacher. For ease of access and transparency, syllabi will also be posted on the district website for parents to review at any time.
