BACKGROUND INFORMATION:



Research shows that the COVID-19 pandemic has had a significant impact on student learning across the nation. In order to support public schools and student learning, the American Rescue Plan signed into law in March by President Joe Biden included billions of dollars for school districts.

Utilizing results of Release 1.0 of the Doss CCSD Stakeholder Engagement Survey Doss Applied for and was awarded Elementary and Secondary School Relieve Funds (ESSER) funds. These funds are designated for one-time or short-term expenditures to address the impact of the ongoing pandemic.

For a two-year period the ESSER III funds are budgeted for use in providing additional support for teachers in the form of training. Funds are budgeted as well to provide additional support for students in the form of special interventions and enrichment activities.
