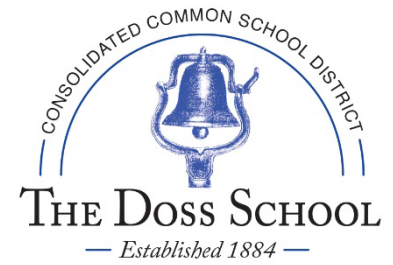

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Research shows that the COVID-19 pandemic has had a significant impact on student learning across the nation. In order to support public schools and student learning, the American Rescue Plan signed into law in March by President Joe Biden included billions of dollars for school districts.

Utilizing results of early surveys, Doss Applied for and was awarded Elementary and Secondary School Relieve Funds (ESSER) funds. These funds are budgeted for use in providing teachers training. Funds are budgeted to provide support for students in the form of special interventions and enrichment activities.
