

On Friday, June 14, 2024, the Doss Consolidated Common School District Board of Trustees selected and named

Mr. Joseph Geletka

as the Lone Finalist being considered for the position of **Superintendent of Schools for the District.**

By law, the Board may not hire the new Superintendent for at least 21 days following public notice.

The meeting to hire a superintendent is scheduled for Tuesday, July 9, 2024, at noon.



Mr. Joseph Geletka and his family are eagerly returning home to Texas to serve as Superintendent in Doss CCSD. Mr. Geletka currently serves as the Superintendent for Ironton City School District, after moving to Ohio to help take care of family. Prior to his move to Ohio, Mr. Geletka served in Texas schools for 16 years: Deputy Superintendent for Atlanta ISD, High School Principal in Rockdale and Normangee, and a social studies teacher for Alvin ISD.

Mr. Geletka earned a Superintendent license from the University of Houston in Victoria. His master's was conferred by the University of Houston-Clear Lake, and his bachelor's from Thiel College in Pennsylvania. His philosophy parallels the Doss CCSD Mission *"to create and sustain*

an environment to inspire curiosity, respect tradition, and embrace excellence." Career highlights include implementing preschool for the district, leading a 5-star elementary school, and implementing extracurricular programs.

Supporting his profession and fulfilling his personal life, Joseph Geletka met and married his wife, Rebecca in Texas. Both family oriented, together they welcomed their daughter prior to moving to Ohio when she was ten months old. Mr. Geletka's wife is also an educator who is looking forward to joining and serving a local district. They are thrilled their daughter Emma will attend second grade this fall in Doss School.

Mr. Joseph Geletka's philosophy "aims to create a culture that achieves the best academic and developmental outcomes for each child." Mr. Geletka was named lone finalist June 14th by the Doss Board of Trustees at a time when he will be able to take advantage and utilize his skills, abilities, and experiences to open many new doors for Doss CCSD students, staff, and volunteers.
